


If your matter has finished at the Children's Court or Youth Court, you will have final Care Orders.

Sometimes, those orders will say your children don't get to live with you.

If your Care Orders say this, it can be really tough. You may want to get help and support.

If you think things have changed since the Care Orders were made, you may be able to apply to the court to change or cancel the orders.



To do this, you will need to show that there has been a significant change of your circumstances since the Care Orders were made or last changed. This could include leaving a violent relationship or working with support services to address issues affecting your parenting.

The court will also look at other important things like how long your children have been cared for by their carer, your children's relationship with them, your children's age, the impact on your children of changing their care arrangements again and what is best for your children.
